After collecting a large group of LeWitt's Wall Drawings, Doris and Don Fisher commissioned the artist to create a Wall Drawing for the swimming pool area of their home. LeWitt proposed several ideas, and together they selected *Wall Drawing 895: Loopy Doopy (white and blue)*. This composition can be scaled up or down to fit different spaces; a draftsman who worked extensively with LeWitt in his lifetime provided a precise plan to resize the drawing yet maintain its proportions for the installation here.
